Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)

This MOU made and entered into on this 08 day of January Two thousand twenty one between Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR), a society registered under the societies Registration Act (XXI of 1860) having its registered office at Anusandhan Bhavan, 2, Rafi Marg, New Delhi 110001, India acting through **Indian Institute of Chemical Technology**, a constituent laboratory of CSIR located at Tarnaka, Uppal Road, Hyderabad 500 007, (hereinafter called "CSIR-IICT" which expression shall where the context so admits include its successors and permitted assignees) of the one part,

AND

"VAAGDEVI DEGREE & PG COLLEGE, Hanamkonda, Warangal (hereinafter referred to as VGDP, which expression shall where the context so admits include its successors and permitted assignees) of the other part.

Preamble

Whereas CSIR-IICT is a premier R & D Institute, which has been established to carry out research in chemical sciences leading to innovative processes for a variety of products necessary for human welfare such as food, health, energy and environment and the conduct of R&D work is fully geared to meet the requirements of technology development, transfer and commercialization.

Whereas VGDP is established in 1993 at Hanamkonda, affiliated to Kakatiya University, Warangal. The college offers courses for the under grads & MSc, MBA & MCA programmes. Most of the faculties possess their doctoral degree. Their vision is to offer skill enhancing value education that help students to become useful citizens to society.

Whereas CSIR-IICT and VGDP desires to enter into a MoU setting forth the terms and conditions of the collaboration.

The MOU details the objectives of the collaboration, responsibilities and obligations of each party and other terms and conditions.

1. Objective of Collaboration

CSIR- IICT and VGDP have agreed to collaborate in the following areas:

- Teaching, Research and Training in selected and advanced thrust areas in S&T.
- To collaborate and write project proposals in areas of mutual interest and submit to various Agencies/Industries for funding.
- Exchange of scientists, faculty & students in collaborative projects on areas of expertise as mentioned above, as per the norms of respective institutes

2. Scope of Collaboration

CSIR-IICT and VGDP agreed to enter into separate agreements on case-to-case basis, with the scope of work involving terms and conditions, financial arrangements, Intellectual Property Rights and respective responsibilities.

3. General terms

CSIR-IICT or VGDP are is free to sign MOU with any other parties in India or overseas for similar work at their own discretion.

4. Confidentiality

During the tenure of the MOU and thereafter, both CSIR-IICT and VGDP undertake on their behalf and on behalf of their subcontractors/ employees / representatives / associates to maintain strict confidentiality and prevent disclosure thereof, of all the information and data exchanged / generated pertaining to work under this MOU for any purposes other than in accordance with this MOU.

5. Force Majeure

Neither party shall be held responsible for non-fulfillment of their respective obligations under this Agreement due to the exigency of one or more of the force majeure event such as but not limited to acts of God, war, flood earthquakes, strike, lockouts epidemics, riots, civil commotion, etc. Provided on the occurrence and cessation of any such events, the party affected thereby shall give a notice in writing to the other party within one month of such occurrence or cessation. If the force-majeure condition continues beyond six months, the parties shall then mutually decide about the future course of action.

6. Effective date, duration, termination of the MOU

6.1. The MOU shall be effective from the date of signing and shall remain in force for three years.

6.2. The MOU shall terminate on the expiry of the period, as in clause 6.1 unless extended by both parties.

6.3. During the tenure of the MOU, parties hereto can terminate the MOU either for breach of any of the terms and conditions of this MOU or otherwise by giving 2

months' notice in writing to the defaulting party. Failure of either party to terminate the MOU on account of breach or default by the other shall not constitute a waiver of that party's right to terminate this MOU.

6.4. In the event of termination of the MOU vide 6.3 the rights and obligations of the parties, thereto shall be settled by mutual discussion.

7. Notices

All notices and other communications required to be served on VGDP under the terms of this MOU shall be considered to be duly served if the same shall have been delivered to, left with or posted by registered mail to VGDP at its last known address of business. Similarly, any notice to be given to the CSIR-IICT shall be considered duly served if the same shall have been delivered to, left with or posted by registered mail to Indian Institute of Chemical technology, Hyderabad.

8. Amendments to the MOU

No amendment or modification of this MOU shall be valid, unless the same is made in writing by both the parties or their authorized representatives and specifically stating the same to be an amendment of this MOU. The modifications/changes shall be effective from the date on which they are made/ executed, unless otherwise agreed to.

9. Assignment of MOU

The rights and/or liabilities arising to any party to this MOU shall not be assigned except with the written consent of the other party and subject to such terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed upon.

10. Arbitration

Any dispute arising out of this MOU, the same shall be referred to the arbitration of 3 (three) arbitrators, one to be appointed by each party to the dispute, and the third and presiding arbitrator shall be nominated by the said two arbitrators before entering into any reference. The decision of the majority of arbitrators shall be final and binding on both parties. The venue of arbitration shall be at Hyderabad and the arbitration proceedings shall take place under the provisions Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996

NOW THIS MOU WITNESSETH AS UNDER:

This is an agreement for a synergic alliance between **Vaagdevi Degree & P.G. college** and **Planet solutions** for the social cause of recycling of Dry Waste and Environment Protection through recycling.

This MOU shall be for a period of three years commencing from the date of Signing of this MOU.

Roles and Responsibilities of Vaagdevi Degree & P.G. college:

COLLEGE is a leading Institution in Telangana and an approved institution by AICTE and affiliated to Kakatiya University, Warangal;

SAP EDUCATION PARTNER and COLLEGE along with SAP India are willing to jointly establish a strategic relationship, where parties shall work together in number of ways for setting-up of an on-campus training center at COLLEGE's campus, India ("**On-Campus Training Centre**") in order to provide SAP End-user Courses to the students of COLLEGE;

THIS AGREEMENT SPELLS OUT THE STRATEGIC COLLABORATION BETWEEN THE PARTIES FOR UTILIZATION OF CORE COMPETENCIES, EXPERTISE, INFRASTRUCTURE, KNOWLEDGE, TECHNICAL KNOW-HOW AND BUSINESS INFORMATION FOR BENEFITS OF STUDENTS OF THE COLLEGE AND THE COLLEGE itself.

1. Goals of this Agreement

- b. The Parties shall have clearly defined roles and responsibilities for the setting-up and functioning of the said SAP e-learning center at COLLEGE Campus.

The parties desire to cooperate with each other and the following is the underlined broad understanding between the parties:



3. Mutual Roles and Responsibilities

The Responsibilities of SAP EDUCATION PARTNER and COLLEGE are as follows:

a. Responsibilities of SAP EDUCATION PARTNER

SAP EDUCATION PARTNER shall be responsible for the following;

- i. SAP Education Partner shall deliver the following within 14 days of receipt of PO and Full Payment from COLLEGE
 - a. A single pack of Logins for SAP Cloud Platform which shall be valid for a period of six (6) months from date of issue, the number of logins being as described in Appendix 2 of this Agreement or in multiples of this number.
 - ii. In all sixty-four (64) hours of instructor-led training to students of COLLEGE as per number of Logins procured by COLLEGE. The sixty-four (64) hours of instructor-led training shall be delivered over eight (8) sessions with eight (8) hours per session. The batch size for the training shall be sixty (60) or multiples of sixty (60). The topics covered in the Training shall be as in Appendix 1 to this AGREEMENT.
 - a. Conduct Online Assessment of trained students at COLLEGE using SAP's Questionmark Perception (QMP), the number of concurrent assessments being as described in Appendix 2 of this Agreement. Students shall be provided a maximum of three (3) attempts to pass the Online Assessment. There are restrictions on the duration within which certification for a particular version needs to be completed.
 - iii. SAP Education Partner shall provide a course completion certificate to all students who have successfully completed the aforesaid training and passed the Online Assessment.
 - iv. SAP Education Partner under the guidance and support of SAP India would organize a Job-Fair for SAP trained students at a common location which shall be decided in due course.

b. Responsibilities of COLLEGE

COLLEGE shall be responsible for following:

- vii. The Payment Terms for the Fees shall be as in Appendix 2 of this Agreement.

5. Course Content and Curriculum

- i. The course curriculum shall be as described in Appendix 1 of this Agreement.
- ii. The course curriculum shall be as recommended by SAP India, from time-to-time.
- iii. The course curriculum may be changed by SAP with sufficient advance notice.

6. Use of Training Materials and Copyright

Under this AGREEMENT, COLLEGE shall receive, handle and use SAP Proprietary Information in a manner as specified by SAP from time to time. In no event, COLLEGE shall



copy, translate, disassemble, or decompile, nor create or attempt to create any part of the SAP Proprietary Information.
